Floor 2: Prosthetic/Orthotic Lab, Over the Counter Stock Goods.

Floor 3: Dialysis, Health Psychology, Pain Clinic, Transition and Care Management.

BUILDING H: Inpatient South

Floor 1: Spinal Cord Injury.

Floor 2: Mental Health.

BUILDING K: Inpatient North

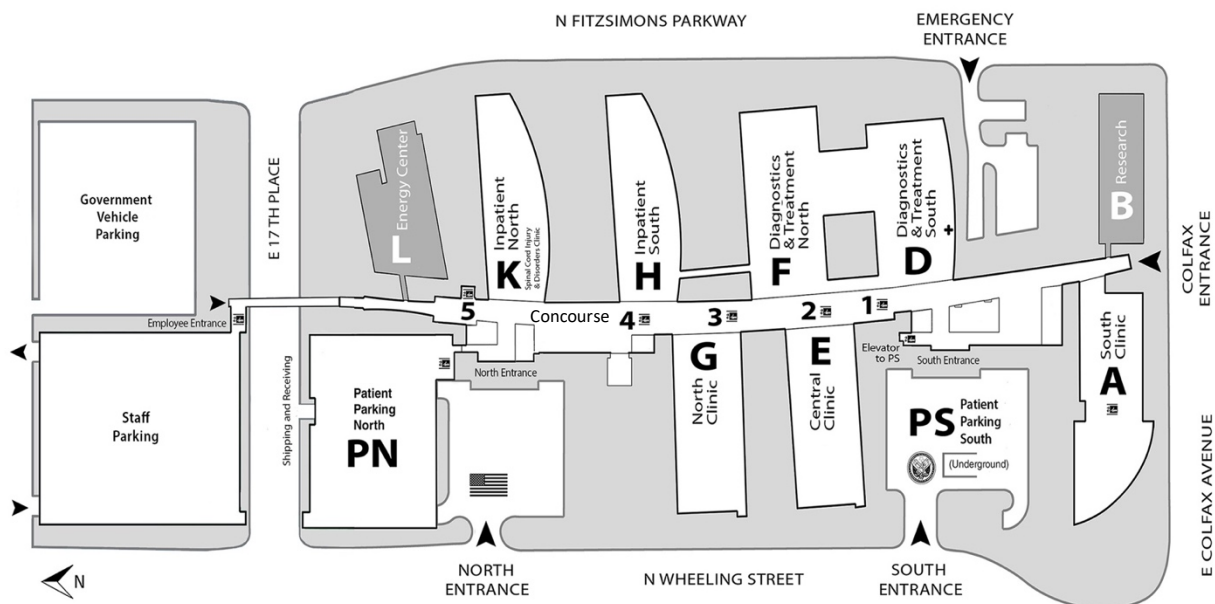
Floor 1: Outpatient Spinal Cord Injury, Spinal Cord Injury Pharmacy.

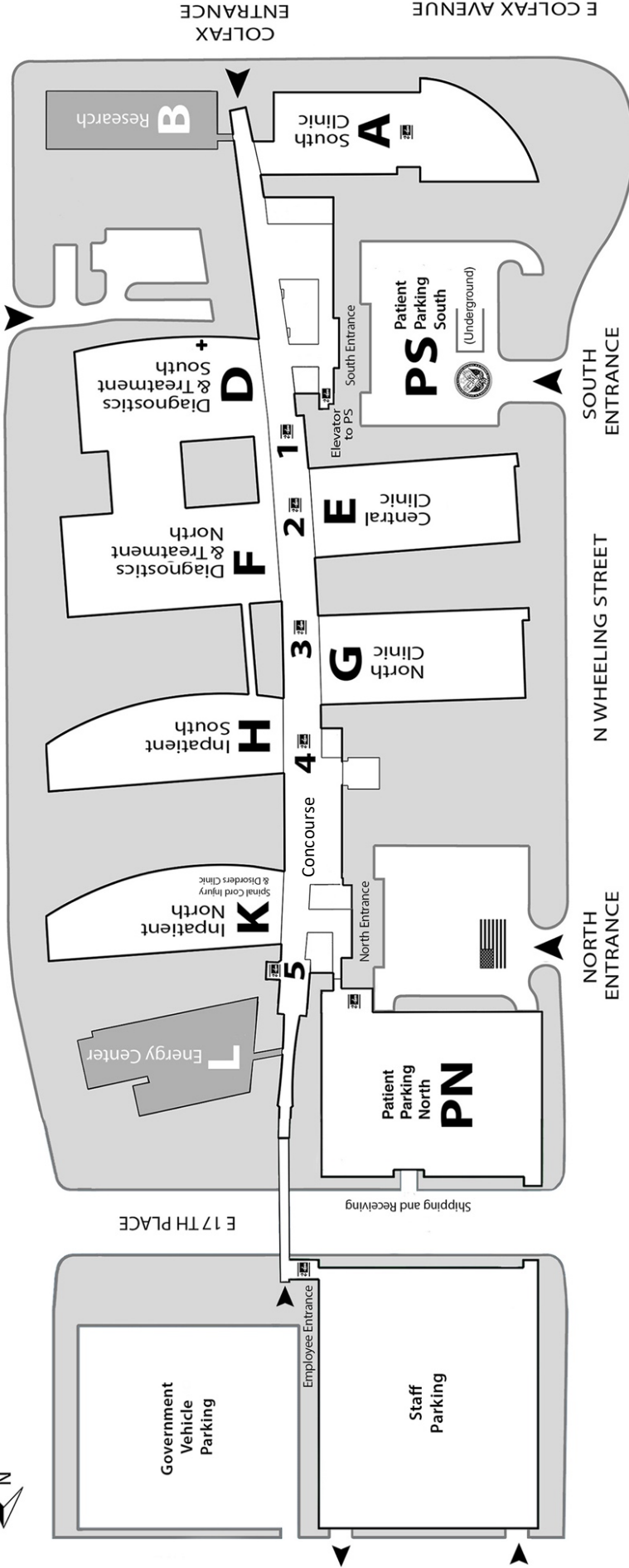

Rocky Mountain Regional VA Medical Center vehicle registration and parking information:

Patient and visitor parking is provided free of charge in Patient Parking North (PN), located next to the North (Flag) Entrance, and In-Patient Parking South (PS), located next to the South (Seals) Entrance. Vehicle height restrictions in all parking structures is 7'1". High clearance handicap side lift parking is available on the surface lot of Patient Parking (PS).

Prior to August 6, vehicle registration can be completed at the Denver VA Medical Center at **1055 Clermont St. Denver CO 80220** with VA Police Dispatch. After August 6, vehicle registration can be completed at the Rocky Mountain Regional VA Medical Center at **1700 N. Wheeling St. Aurora, CO** at the VA Police check-in window in Building D. **If your current vehicles were previously registered with the VA Police, you don't need repeat this effort.**
