### Try Scuba Diving

#### What is scuba diving?

Scuba diving, as a human activity, it is the practice of descending below the water's surface to interact with the environment. Scuba divers carry their own source of breathing gas, usually compressed air, allowing them greater independence and freedom.

#### What is the Try Scuba Diving?

The Try Scuba program provides participants with an introductory scuba experience with an SSI Classified Professional in a pool/confined water environment. All equipment and instruction are provided free of charge.

#### Who is Denver Adaptive Divers?

As a Colorado 501c(3) organization, Denver Adaptive Divers and Denver Divers provides support, education, specialized training and dive travel to qualified individuals with physical disabilities to enable them to become an integral part in the sport of scuba diving.

#### How do we do this?

We use the Scuba Schools International Classified diving training program to provide training and Open Water Diver certification to people with a variety of disabilities.

#### How do I get started?

Step 1: Go to [www.denveradaptivedivers.org](http://www.denveradaptivedivers.org)

Step 2: Go to the **Upcoming events** box and click it

Step 3: Read about our Try Scuba event including the medical considerations, download and complete the **Medical Statement and Guidelines form**, you fill out pages 1 and 2, page 3 must be filled out and signed by your physician

Step 4: Click on the **Book Now** button

Step 5: Select one of the date tabs that works for you

Step 6: Read this page and then click on **Select Students**

Step 7: **Set up an account**, if you are a first time participant you will have to create an account by entering your email address, confirming you are 18 or older and completing a privacy statement. You will then be sent a verification code that allows you to complete all required forms.

Step 8: Once Denver Adaptive Divers receives your paper work you will be contacted by Craig Hilton with your Try Scuba time slot.
