Leaders for Life

- If an applicant is seeking a scholarship in Phase II right now, it will be a three year 2021 fall start.
- Applicants will not be accepted if they are already enrolled in an ROTC Program. If they are already in the program they should compete for campus based GRFD at the program level.



Dates & Deadlines



Leaders for Life

- **01DEC2020** is the deadline for scholarship packets.
- Scholarship packets can take weeks to process. We ask that nominations are submitted **NLT two weeks** prior to the deadline giving the USACC Program personnel sufficient time to complete the nomination process.
- Scholarship packets that are not completed and submitted by the 01DEC2020 deadline will not be considered.



Eligibility Requirements

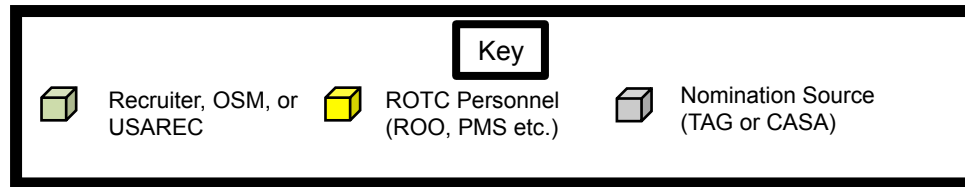
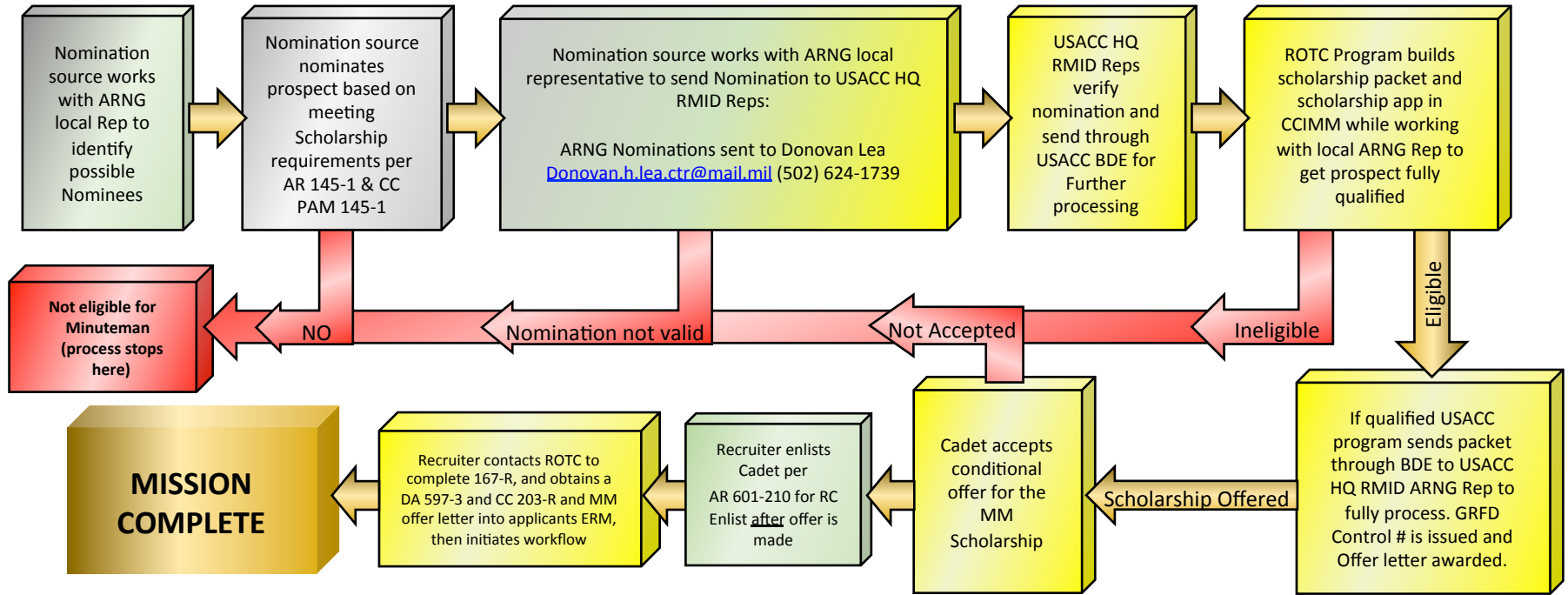
- Currently in ARNG or eligible to enlist
- Not currently in a ROTC Program
- U.S. Citizen
- Between the ages of 17-26
- Valid MEPS Chapter 2 physical for enlistment
- DoDMERB physical for ROTC “scheduled” for scholarship offer and completed DoDMERB to contract with ROTC
- Pass a physical fitness assessment to contract
- Be in compliance with AR 600-9 Body Composition standards
- Official College / University acceptance letter
- 4YR and 3AD scholarship applicants require: 2.5 High School GPA, 1000 SAT or 19 ACT
- Once contracted maintain 2.0 College GPA
- Participate in Simultaneous Membership Program (SMP)
- Once commissioned, 8-year service obligation actively drilling at a Unit

Leaders for Life

- **Nomination Memo should contain:**
 1. Name of candidate
 2. Name of institution
 3. Length of scholarship
 4. Hand written or digitally signed signature block
 5. Indicate the nomination is for Phase II

- All nominations should be submitted to Mr. Donovan Lea (ARNG)

- If multiple names are on one memo, please provide 1-3 above in memo
