CDL BUS DRIVER:

- Must be at least 21 years old and obtain/maintain a valid Colorado commercial driver's license (CDL) Class B with P2S.
- A high school diploma (or equivalent) is required.
- Paid CDL training available.
- Starting pay is \$20.43 per hour.
- Monday through Friday, 6.5 to 8 hours per shift.
- Position is subject to federal drug testing standards.

NON-CDL BUS DRIVER:

- Must be at least 21 years old, obtain/maintain a valid Colorado driver's license and meet the district's insurability standards. A high school diploma (or equivalent) is required.
- Paid training available.
- Starting pay is \$16.89 per hour.
- Monday through Friday, 6.5 to 8 hours per shift.
- Position is subject to federal drug testing standards.

BUS PARAPROFESSIONAL:

- Must be at least 18 years old and be able to assist students with special needs.
- A high school diploma (or equivalent) is required.
- Paid training available.
- Starting pay is \$15.87 per hour.
- Monday through Friday, 6.5 to 8 hours per shift.

BENEFITS: Denver Public Schools offers a variety of benefits for employees, including health, vision and dental insurance, as well as contributions to the Colorado PERA retirement plan. If you meet the following criteria, you are eligible for a bonus

CDL New Hire Bonus- New CDL drivers will be given **\$2,000** in three disbursements: After you complete your training, in the mid-year and at the beginning of the new school year. Any employee who converts from their current role into a CDL driver is eligible for this bonus.

No CDL New Hire Bonus- Drivers who plan to get their CDL will be given **\$1,500** in three disbursements: After you complete your training, in the mid-year and at the beginning of the new school year.

Ask about even more bonuses, including attendance bonuses and a bonus for referring someone who gets hired.
