OVERVIEW

For many veterans and military families, transitioning to civilian life presents many obstacles, including finding an affordable place to live and securing employment to support themselves and their families. To address these challenges, Operation Homefront is launching a new program that will assist in the successful transition of recently separated veterans. Operation Homefront's Transitional Housing - Apartments will provide veterans with a rent/utilities free apartment for one year, while giving them the opportunity to utilize both employment and financial counselor services to help achieve stability and chart a path to long-term post military success.

Who is eligible?

- Veteran, with or without family within 4 years of discharge
- Veteran within 200 miles of Home of Record preferred
- Veteran with honorable discharge (to include general under honorable conditions)
- Veteran who is not eligible for retirement pay
