Serves as the primary medical case manager for the battalion by facilitating all required medical/administrative functions with the goal of "return to duty" status for all SMs. This may include, but is not limited to: coordinating procurement of medical records (military, VA, and civilian); scheduling profile reviews; LOD, INCAP and MMSO assistance; ADME/MRP2 assistance; MAR2 coordination; and MEB/PEB assistance. Maintain access and achieve proficiency in requisite web-based medical programs, to include MEDCHART and MODS Modules (requires annual HIPAA certification). Responsible for ensuring their supported units understand Class VIII (medical supply) requisitioning. Responsible for the accountability and mission readiness of assigned medical personnel (e.g. 68W Sustainment and Provider Credentialing).
