## **Adolescent Programs**



Our adolescent programs treat mental health concerns including depression, anxiety and other emotional challenges.

**Inpatient Treatment** - **The Discovery Program** is for youth ages 11 to 17 and focuses on assessment and stabilization.

We provide 24-hour care and take a holistic approach to treatment that includes:

- Group therapy
- Experiential therapy
- Yoga
- Psychosocial education
- Medication management 
  Family meetings
  - Discharge planning
- Relapse prevention

The multidisciplinary team of psychiatrists, nurse managers, nurses, social workers/therapists, experiential therapists, and behavioral health advocates work together to give your child his or her best chance for recovery.



## **Adolescent Programs**

**Outpatient Programs** - Our outpatient programs focus on supporting clients as they progress toward wellness. The emphasis is on emotional regulation, relational dynamics and building resiliency.

**Summit** is our **Partial Hospitalization Program (PHP)** designed for adolescents ages 11 to 17. Program components include medication monitoring, evidencebased group therapy, weekly family meetings and collaboration with schools and outpatient providers. The program meets 5 days a week for 6 hours each day. We offer a lodging option to accommodate patients.

Altitude is our Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP) for adolescents ages 11 to 17 designed as a more structured level of care offering nine hours of therapy per week. Treatment includes evidence-based group therapy, family involvement and collaboration with schools and outpatient providers. The program meets 3 days a week for 3 hours each day.
